It is an important part of your application as it will be used by the Show Garden selection panel in the process of accepting gardens to the Show. It also forms part of the judging criteria, as marks are allocated for realisation of brief.

When submitting this form, please also supply the following supporting documents in PDF format (or JPEG for design drawings):

- 1) Completed application
- 2) Two overall plan drawings in colour showing the garden from different perspectives. Please ensure you submit an accurate, detailed plan that clearly reflects the design of your garden to its best effect. Please also indicate the location of any proposed rear or backdrop to the garden. If submitting hand drawings, do not send originals.
- 3) Any other relevant details such as example buildings, sculptures, unusual features.

If accepted, you are then required to submit the following by Friday 20th January:

- 4) Proof of Public Liability Insurance for £5million.
 - 5) Risk assessment for all contractors assisting in the build of the garden.
 - 6) Any final changes or alterations to your proposed layout and/or brief.
